

Family Swim Hours

Indoor Pools:

- Saturday & Sunday: 1pm – 6pm
- Monday: 10am – 12pm & 12pm – 4pm (Lap Pool Only)
- Tuesday: 2pm – 4pm & 7pm – 9:30pm
- Thursday: 2pm – 4pm & 7pm – 9:30pm
- Friday: 6pm – 9:30pm

Outdoor Pool

- Daily: 10am – 8pm

- **Flotation Devices:** Inflatables, such as water wings and floats, are not permitted. United States Coast Guard approved life jackets are permitted with direct adult participation.
- **Age Requirements:** A responsible adult, 18 years or older, must accompany children under the age of 13 at all times, and be responsible for their behavior. An adult can only supervise a maximum of five children. Children under the age of 13 may only be permitted in the lap pool during non-family swim hours if they are swimming continuous laps without stopping mid-way, do not require the use of a flotation device, or need assistance. A swim test may be required.
- **Young Children:** Children not fully toilet trained must wear snug fitting plastic pants over a swim diaper. Regular diapers are not permitted. Diaper changing is not permitted in the pool area.
- **Authorized Users:** Family Swim Hours are reserved for members and paid guests of members. Non-member swim lessons and other activity participants are restricted to their scheduled activities only. Child members and paid guests must display proper wrist bands during Family Swim attendance.
- **Inclement Weather Policy:** During inclement weather, outside swimming does *NOT* move indoors unless it is during the scheduled Family Swim Hours.
- **Adult Swim:** During the summer season, the lifeguard will clear the pool of swimmers *under the age of 16 every hour for fifteen minutes*. Adults holding an infant will be permitted in the pool during this time.
